Pilots and patients are the heart and soul of LLP.

Two of the pilots who flew numerous missions in 2015, Peyton M, Illinois; and Bob B., Colorado, also are LLP board members, bringing the skills, insights and compassion that are characteristic of the dedicated fliers who navigate that distance between hope and home for patients in need.

"I'm able to share the joy of flight with patients, and that takes their minds off their medical challenges," Peyton explains. "After we take off, the level of excitement and rapid fire questions tell me that the patients' spirits are lifted.

"Each patient I transport becomes my favorite, child or adult, although the little ones do tend to stick with me longer. They often don't understand what's going on, and all they want is a chance to grow up."
