"If it weren't for all these volunteers and caring people, I would never be able to get the treatment I needed to continue life," states Amy.

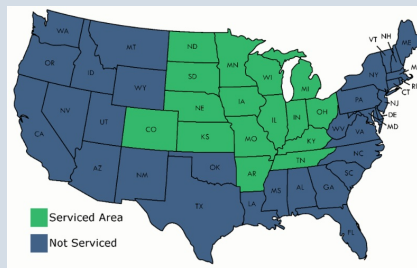
